

COUNTRY PROFILE **United Kingdom**

Healthcare in the United Kingdom (UK) is devolved to the four nations of England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.

A diverse landscape of academic and commerical research from fundamental discovery to product development and implementation is supported across the UK through grant funding, focussed commisioning and support for automonous research institues like the Pirbright. The UK government directly hosts major research facilities, including public health laboratories within the UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA), dedicated to prevention, preparation and response to infectious diseases, and the Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA), with a mandate to identify, research and control diseases and pests in animals, plants and bees.

The UK's rapid and successful research response to the COVID-19 pandemic would not have been possible without the extensive support, coordination and infrastructure provided by the National Institute for Health and Care Research (NIHR) and UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) devoted to academic research across disciplinary boundaries working in partnership with the research support and infrastructure provided by the Devolved Nations. This supported research studies and trials across the UK including 125 COVID-19 studies delivered across Wales, and 205 COVID-19 studies delivered in Scotland, for example.

In 2023, government funders of health research and related partners across all four nations developed a cross-government research and development framework and governance structure for pandemic prevention, preparedness and response. This has been implemented to coordinate research funding and prioritisation for pandemic preparedness and outbreak response.
