# The Slovak Republic

In 2020, Slovakia established the Central Crisis Management Group, which included representatives from all relevant ministries and public authorities, to coordinate the country's response to the pandemic. Prior to COVID-19, Slovakia's 2005 pandemic preparedness plan only covered influenza. The COVID-19 pandemic has shown the importance of robust health data infrastructure to deliver real-time data suitable for policy- and decision-making. https://health.ec.europa.eu/system/files/2021-12/2021 chp sk english.pdf ) The Public Health Authority in Slovakia is responsible for monitoring AMR in humans since 2001, and co-operates with the veterinary service that monitors AMR in animals. An expert AMR committee was set up in the Ministry of Health in 2009, and was tasked to prepare the National Action Plan on AMR for 2019-21, approved in 2018. Overall consumption of defined daily doses (DDDs) of antibiotics per 1 000 population in Slovakia was just above the EU average in 2021. However, the share of antibiotics that should only be used for a specific, limited number of indications (59 %) was considerably higher than the EU average (40 %).
